# Locum Positions at the Oklahoma Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory

#### **About the Positions:**

The Oklahoma Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory (OADDL) is seeking board certified or board-eligible anatomic pathologists to provide locum support from **July 5**, **2024**, **to January 3**, **2025**. Flexible scheduling within these dates is available, with a preference for 1-4 week blocks. Responsibilities include covering necropsy service, training senior veterinary students and residents, and consulting with clients on assigned cases. Daily support to residents while completing diagnostic service duties is also required.

The OADDL necropsy caseload is diverse, with submissions from the OSU Veterinary Teaching Hospital and external veterinary practices. In 2023, OADDL conducted 836 necropsies, spanning various species – the top 3 species being dogs (20%), cattle (18%), and horses (16%). The necropsy facility is spacious, well equipped, and supported by a high-quality histology laboratory.

OADDL is located on the campus of Oklahoma State University in sunny Stillwater, OK, which offers numerous opportunities for outdoor activities, dining, and sporting events. Stillwater has a commercial airport served by American Airlines flights to/from DFW and is conveniently situated approximately 1 hour by car from both Oklahoma City and Tulsa.

## **Minimum Requirements:**

- DVM or equivalent degree plus ACVP or ECVP board eligibility
- Authorization to work in the United States at the time of employment
- Successful completion of Oklahoma State University's background screen

#### **Compensation:**

A competitive stipend will be offered.
