I really liked that Dr. Affolter did a 1+1 topic/time approach. Questions in the middle allowed for a stretch break and to re-focus for the next topic. Dr. Bradley's topic almost needed more time - there was so much information (all very valuable). I was very happy to see Drs. Mauldin and Affolter referring back to the patterns he initially discussed, it helped me solidify those a bit better. Overall it was a very cohesive group of lectures. I really appreciated Dr. Linder's "Road map" for his talk. Helped me remember where we were at and made a very gen. path heavy talk much easier to follow. I also liked that Dr. Mauldin used her cat as a visual cue that she was about to change to a different topic. Made it easy for my overwhelmed brain to keep topics in boxes and not have them run together. The comparative pathology approach was also very helpful for me.
