 - YT organization

 - Rachel, Rafa, Jey, and Bruce contributed to the organization brainstorming, and some strategies we (Fabio, Laura, and myself) will follow up with is to create 1) playlists based on webinar category (ex: Free Friday, Portuguese, Spanish); and 2) hashtags including #main theme, #speaker's name, #organs

system, #animal species, #year.

- Stats representative
 - Peres Badial is our current volunteer who tackles data compilation about our Zoom webinars on a monthly basis. He is extremely busy with this residency routine, so he has limited time to go over the data and share them with us as a group.
 - We will probably need another volunteer to go over Pere's data presentation and summarize it for us during one of the Committee's monthly meetings.

 - Rachel will get back to Peres to clarify some confusing webinar numbers in the most recent compilations.
- Website (events/memberpress)
 - Laura Setyo's contact, who maintains the British Society of Veterinary Pathologists, could be a good source to teach some of us how to extract the full potential of syncing webinars broadcasting with the website (10/19/21 follow-up: Laura's contact is currently busy and won't be able to help us).
 - Rachel will prepare an announcement to ask for volunteers knowledgeable on that field AND look for hired professional assistance at the same time.
 - Jey and Rachel summarized some of our current needs:
 - Webinars on demand, syncing with social media, automation of certificates, reminder messages, contents restricted to members/registrants, etc.

- Blog posts
 - We discussed pending / potential posts to be added: Awards Ceremony, monthly image award (some info about the winner), contests announcements, volunteering callouts...
 - Another tool to explore with Event Promoter is a notification to be sent to members when a new blog post is available.
- Link about the volunteering work on the website
 - We agreed that having a direct form can be tricky and trigger an impulsive fleeting decision for volunteering.
 - Eileen suggested we can post a more descriptive and realistic announcement about what our volunteer entails. We agreed this was a great idea and Rachel will work on a blog post about that.
- Jey brought up the idea of having a sole volunteer to be the "liaison" between Paco/Jey and the speakers set up for future seminars. That person would be responsible for:
 - Keeping track of form entries and make sure speakers fill the form out in a timely manner.
 - Communicating with the Graphics, RACE, and moderators/host teams about webinar title, date, hour, CVs availability, headshots, etc.

 Eileen brought up an interesting point about potential bias on registrants/attendees' specialties between registration vs. surveymonkey entires. And it would be curious to compare those two and confirm if they match or don't.
